General Information

Point Guard –

Here is some information for the program that you will be attending...

Arrival/Departure

Registration is from 1:00 p.m. until 2:00 p.m. on the first day of camp. Camp will start on the first day at 3:00 p.m. and will go until 11:00 p.m. – So come rested and ready to learn! We will be spending much of the first day in the classroom, setting the stage for the rest of your week. The program ends around 11:00 a.m. on the last day. Check-out will be held at this time, in the same place as registration.

Parent Meeting

We will be holding an optional parent meeting at 2:30 p.m. on the first day of camp. This is a chance for parents to ask questions and to meet our directors. The session will meet at 2:25 p.m. at the registration location.

Housing

Occupancy is usually two to a room. We will do our best to accommodate everyone who requests a roommate. Otherwise we will assign a roommate for you.

Key Deposit

Please be aware that colleges require us to collect a key deposit in the amount of \$50 at check-in. We ask that this be in the form of a **check** made out to National Point Guard Camp. This check will be returned to you when you return your key. If you are unable to pay the \$50, you will still be admitted to the program – you just won't be able to lock your door.

Payment

Any remaining balance must be received at least one month before your program begins. Please make your check or money order payable to National Point Guard Camp. Be sure to include the athlete's name and program location on the check, and send it c/o NPGC, 533 Warrendale Rd., Mars, PA, 16046.

Cancellations & Refunds

Should you need to cancel for any reason, please do so in writing. A cancellation that is received at least one month prior to your program will be refunded, less the \$175 deposit. No refunds will be given after this deadline. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** If you are injured prior to the camp, you can still observe or you can trade your spot to another athlete.

PLEASE NOTE: If we do not receive notification at least one month before your program, neither deposits nor payments will be applicable to programs other than the one for which you have reserved a spot.
